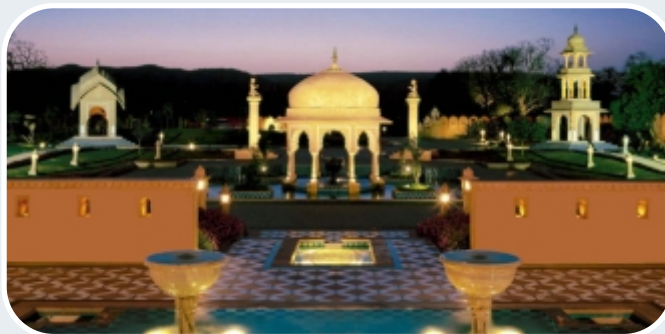
## The Oberoi Amarvilas, Agra
